Scott Opitz moved to allow Marvin Shaw to begin negotiations at \$100,000.00 cash and the trade of our 2 acres on Hwy 64. Heath Morris seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Scott Opitz moved to table the agenda item to consider calling for an election for a sales tax. Heath Morris seconded the motion to lay on the table. The motion carried.
